“Lake Huron to Lake Superior – Beavers, Mulligan joins Jacks Hockey”

Northland College Hockey is pleased to announce the commitment of Defensemen Ryan Mulligan to their 2019 recruiting class. Mulligan is a Native of Sault Ste. Marie, ON, Canada and spent this past season with the Blind River Beavers of the NOJHL.

The blue line stalwart has played in 215 total junior hockey games in his career and has produced 29 goals, 80 Assists and 188 penalty minutes during that time. His ability to provide some secondary scoring and defend down-low was something that caught the Northland staff's attention.

Head Men's Hockey Coach and Interim Director of Athletics, Seamus Gregory commented on Mulligan joining the program. “The process with Ryan, the Beavers staff and of course his family has been going on for quite some time and we are ecstatic he has decided that Northland College is that place he wants to be. He can skate, jump up in the rush when called upon, his compete level is off the charts, plays hard and cares. With our close proximity to his hometown we have been able to watch him develop over time and know he will be a valuable piece to our blue-line and roster moving forward. In working with the Mulligan Family, Coach Brick and other league personnel, we knew he was a person and player we needed in the room. The NOJHL has been very good to us over time, we love the league, the people and is really one of the diamonds in Canadian Tier II Junior Hockey”.
