



Billeting Guidelines for Players

Communication is KEY.

Remember that no one is a mind reader. You need to communicate your wants and needs and likes and dislikes. ***If you have allergies TELL THEM!*** It's only respectful to inform your billet family if you will be away for a meal, or you have away games they might not be aware of.

Be Always Respectful

Players MUST obey curfew.
